## GLEN DENNY

Glen Denny was one of the leading climbers in Yosemite during the Golden Era. But it was as a photographer and filmmaker that he is best known. For the first time ever Denny will present an exhibition of his photographs that comprises the most comprehensive record of the climbs and characters from that period.

## ACE KVALE

Ace Kvale was working as a ski model in the Alps when he first tried his hand at photography. Since then he has established himself in the top ranks of adventure photographers. His work has been published in dozens of top grade magazines. His travels have taken him throughout the globe. Ace will exhibit a selection of his favourite images and present his acclaimed slide show "Escape to Reality."

## JOHN BACHAR COLLECTION

The photographs of John Bachar soling the Yosemite test pieces of the early eighties amazed the climbing world. These climbs were intimidating enough for the roped climber: to attempt them without protection seemed lunacy. Bachar has proved he was no lunatic and will be at the exhibition

to throw light on that period of his life that was a watershed in climbing standards.

## DAVID EDWARDS

David Edwards has been a freelance photographer for fifteen years and a river guide for twenty five. He has traveled extensively for both professions and has been involved in many first descents of the great rivers, including the Yangtze in China and the Bashkaus in Siberia. His particular area of interest is the Mongolia where his most renowned work, the Kazakh Eagle Hunters

## BRIAN SOKOL

As chief photographer for nepalimage.com, and as a trekking guide Brian Sokol has spent the past seven years commuting between the Himalaya and the mountains of the American West. Brian presents a multimedia exploration of mountain geography and culture, Himalayan Faces: A Portrait of Two Nepals, which will reflect the beauty of the country and its people coupled with a view of the Maoist insurgency that is causing turmoil.
