SIACHEN: A WAR FOR ICE

In what must rank as the most absurd war of all time, and there's plenty of competition for that accolade, Pakistani and Indian troops lob ordnance at one another at altitudes in excess of 23,000 feet. Fulvio Mariani's "A War for Ice" takes a light approach to a grave subject in chronicling the history of the dispute and the day-to-day life of the soldiers involved the world's highest, least-known and most fruitless conflict: the 20-year battle for control of the Siachen glacier located at the extreme northern edge of the Indian-Pakistan border. www.siachen.ch
